

Eagle Scout Requirements

- Completion of all prior ranks including:
 - Scout
 - Tenderfoot
 - Second Class
 - First Class (including 4 months in a Position of Responsibility)
 - Star (including 6 months in a Position of Responsibility)
 - Life (including 6 months in a Position of Responsibility)
- Completion of Eagle Scout Proposal and Fundraising application with appropriate signatures
- Schedule meeting to present proposal to Committee; obtain approvals
- Completion of Eagle Scout Final Report (once proposal and fundraising application are approved)
- Completion of Eagle Scout Project (important to choose something that is important to you and benefits the recipient)
- Completion of Eagle Scout Project Report
- Completion of 21 merit badges (including 13 Eagle required)
- Completion of 5-6 letters of reference (choose carefully, as you will never see the letters of reference; they must be sealed and mailed directly to the Advancement Chair; they will be opened at the Eagle Scout Board of Review for the committee to review and then sent to National) from:
 - Parents
 - Education
 - Religious/Spiritual
 - Work (if employed)
 - 2 additional

It is recommended that you provide a postage-paid envelope addressed to the Advancement Chair (with “your name and letter of reference” written on the front bottom left corner of the envelope) to each person to whom you are requesting a reference.

- Completion of Letter of Ambition
- Completion of Scoutmaster Conference
- Completion of Eagle Scout application (with appropriate signatures)
- Schedule meeting with Advancement Chair to review documentation

When all of the above is completed, the Advancement Chair will take your completed documentation to the Scout Achievement Center to be reviewed by the Eagle Scout Processor. Once it is approved, the Eagle Scout Board of Review can be scheduled.
